Understanding UV Rays

Ultraviolet (UV) light is electromagnetic radiation that's transmitted to Earth from the Sun and radiated over a broad spectrum of wavelengths. Violet is the color of the shortest wavelength of visible light, while ultraviolet light refers to the invisible rays beyond this end of the light spectrum, or "beyond violet." On Earth, we're protected from this direct onslaught of radiation by our atmosphere's stratospheric ozone layer, which absorbs most of the Sun's UV rays.

Depending on the type of radiation, some of the harmful rays can and do reach the Earth's surface. UVA rays are not absorbed by the ozone layer, and UVB rays are only partly absorbed. These are the rays that can cause skin cancer, cataracts, and premature aging of the skin. UV radiation is constant year round, but is the greatest during late spring and early summer.

Reflective surfaces such as sand, snow or water can intensify the effects of these rays, which reach you whether it's cloudy and hazy, or sunny and bright.

Limit your sun exposure when possible and always wear sunscreen.
